Tell me about your experience and how it benefited you?

I joined Momentum Support on Tuesday 8th February 2022 for a 4-day work placement. On the first day I was introduced to the Reception Team, Inga Cabuk and Giselle Rodrigues. They showed me around Momentum House. I accompanied Giselle to observe initially Reception duties. Over the next three days I was assigned key tasks to complete. * Creating booklets for new starter packs. * Sending emails * Updated excel spreadsheets. * Printing documents.

What were the key things you learned during your four days – “Bring your Teenager to Work”?

I was a little nervous on arrival to Momentum House. Once I met Giselle and Inga, I felt so comfortable. Some key learnings were: Listen to understand what needs to be achieved. Follow instruction within set time frames. I had to operate independently when given tasks for example when asked to deliver document upstairs.

Anna, I want to share some tips for transition students and I would appreciate your view point?


Be open minded: “I think that’s a pretty good one! it’s important to consider everything as a teenager as we are still young and may not know what we want.”

Take the opportunities offered: “I think you should consider everything and ultimately do what you want.”

Push Yourself: “It’s important to try your best but also know that you have limits and know you can take breaks.”

Make the most of work experience: “Your work experience can teach you a lot about your likes and dislikes. So, you should not take it for granted.”

Get to know the other people in your year: “You should always try and get to know the people around you. Try and expand you circle of friends.”
